

# Residential Water Regulations 2023

This bulletin outlines the Stage 2 restrictions.



WHEN STAGE 2 RESTRICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT,  
WATERING IS LIMITED TO ONE DAY PER WEEK.

**"ODD" number civic addresses may water on Sunday only.**  
**"EVEN" numbered civic addresses may water on Saturday only.**

At Stage 2, the City will be reducing municipal water consumption by 50%, however may prioritize watering in order to preserve boulevards, planters, and City Park over other grassy spaces.

Stage 2 Regulations	
Dwellings with "ODD" numbered civic addresses	"ODD" numbered civic addresses may water using a manual sprinkler on Sunday between the hours of 6 am to 9 am and 7 pm to 10 pm. Automatically timed sprinklers may water between 12 am and 4 am.
Dwellings with "EVEN" numbered civic addresses	"EVEN" numbered civic addresses may water using a manual sprinkler on Saturday between 6 am to 9 am and 7 pm to 10 pm. Automatically timed sprinklers may water between 12 am to 4 am.
Handheld Watering (spring-loaded nozzle on hose or watering can) or Drip Irrigation watering of food gardens, aesthetic gardens, trees and shrubs.	Watering allowed between 12am-4am, 6am-9am or 7pm-10pm up to 3 days per week. "ODD" numbered civic addresses may water on Wednesday, Friday, Sunday. "EVEN" numbered civic addresses may water on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday,
Sprinkler or non-drip irrigation watering of Food Gardens, Aesthetic Gardens, Trees, Shrubs	Watering allowed with manual sprinklers between 6am-9am and 7pm-10pm 2 days per week; automatically timed sprinklers water between 12am-4am 2 days per week. "ODD" numbered civic addresses may water on Wednesday and Sunday. "EVEN" numbered civic addresses may water on Tuesday and Saturday.
Vehicle (boat/ automobile/ATV/ etc.) Washing	No washing or rinsing except for safety purposes (windows, lights, licenses), or visit a commercial car wash.
Filling of Swimming Pools, Ponds, or Water Features	Filling prohibited. (Exception: Pools may be topped-up one day per week during permitted watering hours.)
