Salvage Coordinator Scope


- Managed proposals and contracts for private house moves and sales
- Coordinated and monitored progress demolition, salvage and house removal works
- Supported site access and safety across contractors, construction activities and house moving
- Monitored site activity

Salvage Coordinator Results

- Established and managed contracts for 8 private house purchases and greater than 20 salvage contracts for 44 items
- Supported house move coordination for 11 City house moves
- Salvage items included appliances, lumber, windows, garage doors, and whole outbuildings
- Assisted with securing empty houses and managed access for salvage proponents and hazardous materials contractors
- Achieved savings of ~\$23,000 demolition cost per house move and \$11,000 in salvage savings total
