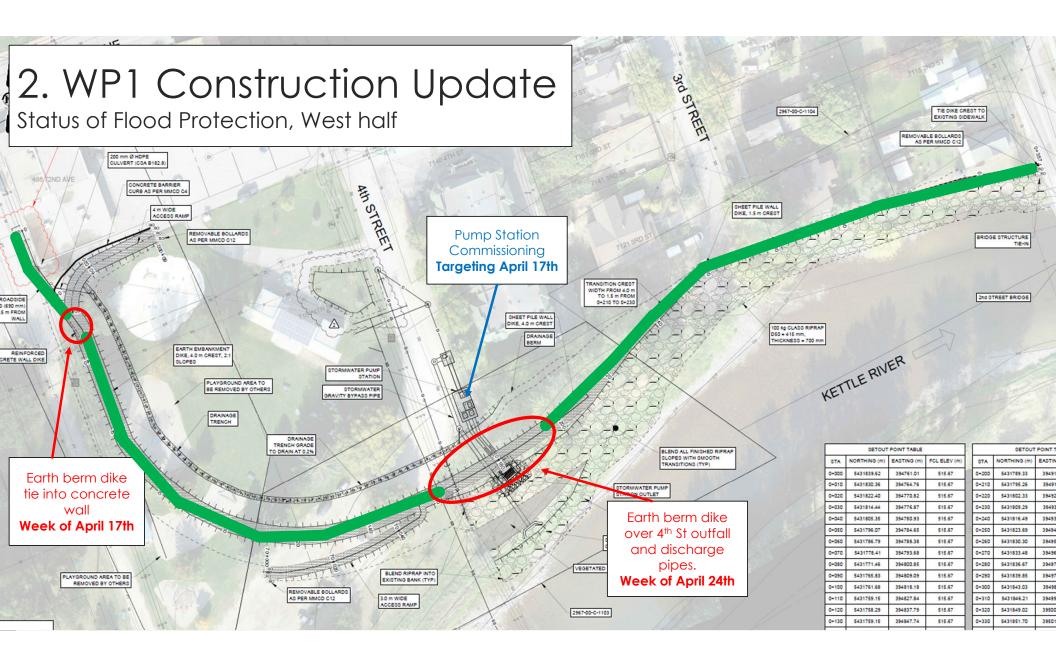

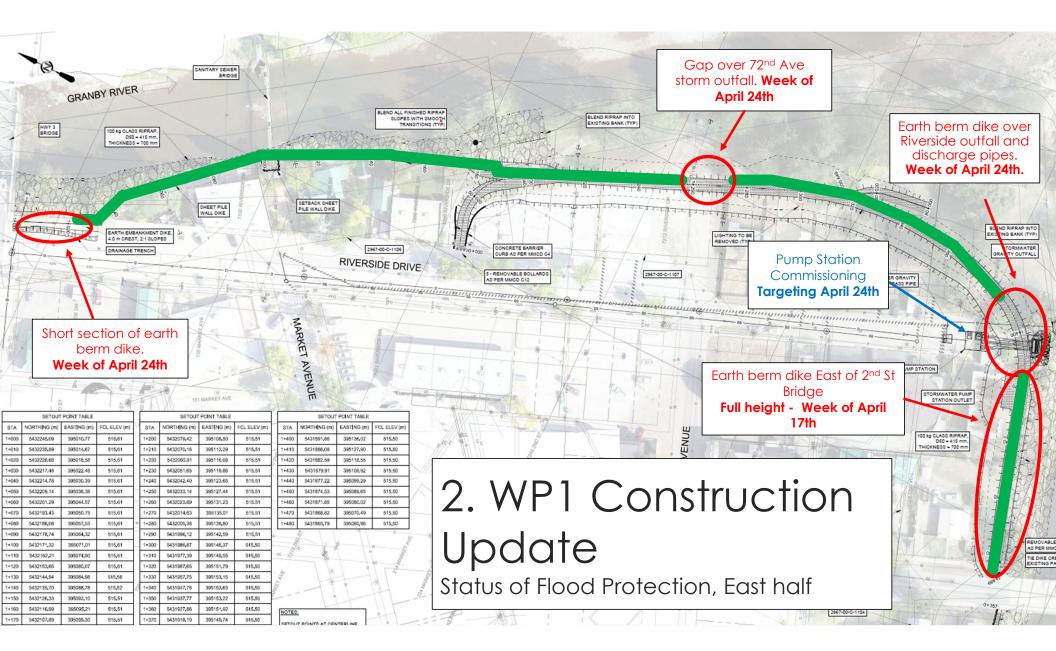

1. Recent Highlights

- A. Removed temp access road in Granby River and completed riprap
- B. Backfilled behind Granby River sheet piles
- C. Built up dike and placed riprap along the Kettle East of 2nd St bridge
- D. Completed all gravity piping and manholes at both pump stations
- E. Built elevated pads for electrical equipment at both pump stations
- F. Filled last gap in North Ruckle dike
- G. Finished capping sheet piles along Interfor dike

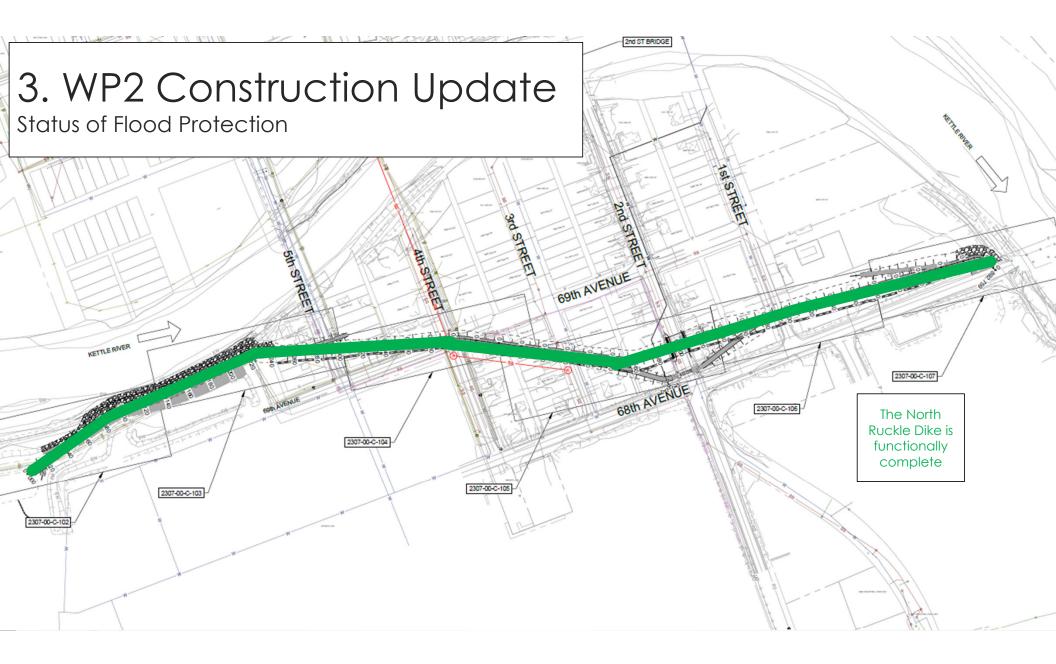

Projected Grand Total to April 2023:

\$44,937,361 + \$3,858,421 = \$48,795,782

Note: While this forecast to the end of April has gone down \$1.1M since the last report, the overall forecast remains the same for the current projects. The \$1.1M has been moved beyond April (see 2023 capital plan slide)
