**BYLAW NO. 1810**

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE OVERWEIGHT TRAFFIC WITHIN  
THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND FORKS**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the Community Charter, Council is authorized to regulate traffic and the use of streets within the City;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Grand Forks, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS** as follows:

**CITATION**

1. This bylaw may be cited, for all purposes, as the **“Overweight Traffic Regulation Bylaw No.1810, 2006.”**

**REGULATION OF OVERWEIGHT TRAFFIC**

Bylaw 1818

2. Unless otherwise posted with traffic control devices indicating a truck route, no person shall drive a truck with a gross vehicle weight in excess of 23,000 kg upon a roadway within the Municipal boundaries, other than an arterial highway, except municipal or utility vehicles, trucks delivering goods and materials to properties on a street or streets directly serviced by the roadway, trucks in parades or used for driver testing.

Notwithstanding the foregoing clause, trucks delivering goods and materials do not include loaded or unloaded logging or chip trucks, and no person shall drive a loaded or unloaded logging or chip truck on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue north to Central Avenue.

**GENERAL**

3. If any section, subsection or clause of this bylaw is held to be invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Bylaw.
4. Every person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) plus the cost of prosecution for each offence.

Read a **SECOND** time this 14th day of August, 2006.

Read a **THIRD** time this 14th day of August, 2006.
