

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF GRAND FORKS

BYLAW NO. 2073

A BYLAW TO IMPLEMENT A MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION PROGRAM FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS.

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The Municipal Council for the Corporation of the City of Grand Forks, in open meeting lawfully assembled, **ENACTS** as follows:

Citation

1. This bylaw may be cited as the “**Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 2073**”

Definitions

2. In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - 2.1 “**Bylaw Enforcement Officer**” means every person(s) designated by Council as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the City, otherwise authorized under the Offence Act or the Police Act, and every Peace Officer;
 - 2.2 “**City**” means the Corporation of the City of Grand Forks;

Policy and Procedure

3. The persons who act in the job positions or titles listed in the Column 4 of Schedule A attached to this Bylaw are designated *Bylaw Enforcement Officers* for the purposes of enforcing Bylaws listed in Column 2 of Schedule A opposite the respective job position.
4. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule B through Schedule S of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of the Community Charter.
- 2073-A1 5. The words or expressions set forth in Column 3 of Schedule B to Schedule T of this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number listed in column 2 of Schedule B through T.
- 2073-A1 6. The dollar amounts in Column 4 of Schedules B through T of this bylaw are the fines for the corresponding offences designated in Column 3 of Schedules B through Schedule T.

Schedules

7. Schedule A through S are attached to this bylaw and form part of this bylaw.

CONSOLIDATED TO INCLUDE BYLAWS 2073, 2073-A1
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General

8. Any enactment referred to herein is a reference to an enactment of British Columbia and regulations thereto, as amended, revised, consolidated or replaced from time to time.
9. If any section, paragraph or phrase of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by a decision of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.

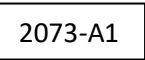
