# **BYLAW NO. 2073**

# A BYLAW TO IMPLEMENT A MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION PROGRAM FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS.

The Municipal Council for the Corporation of the City of Grand Forks, in open meeting lawfully assembled, **ENACTS** as follows:

# **Citation**

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 2073"

## **Definitions**

- 2. In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
  - 2.1 **"Bylaw Enforcement Officer"** means every person(s) designated by Council as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the City, otherwise authorized under the <u>Offence Act</u> or the <u>Police</u> <u>Act</u>, and every Peace Officer;
  - 2.2 "City" means the Corporation of the City of Grand Forks;

#### **Policy and Procedure**

- 3. The persons who act in the job positions or titles listed in the Column 4 of Schedule A attached to this Bylaw are designated *Bylaw Enforcement Officers* for the purposes of enforcing Bylaws listed in Column 2 of Schedule A opposite the respective job position.
- 4. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule B through Schedule S of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of the Community Charter.
- 5. The words or expressions set forth in Column 3 of Schedule B to Schedule T of this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number listed in column 2 of Schedule B through T.
- 6. The dollar amounts in Column 4 of Schedules B through T of this bylaw are the fines for the corresponding offences designated in Column 3 of Schedules B through Schedule T.

#### **Schedules**

7. Schedule A through S are attached to this bylaw and form part of this bylaw.

- 9. If any section, paragraph or phrase of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by a decision of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.
