## #1. COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS WORKSHOP



Council hosted a Community Stakeholders workshop intending to receive presentations from organizations that provide marketing and or tourism services to the community. This workshop was very successful and received presentations from local organizations and their goals for this upcoming year. Council hopes to continue this workshop on an annual basis as part of the budget process for the following year.

## #2. SKATEPARK



Council approved for the City to enter into a stewardship agreement with Discover Grand Forks / Boundary Regional Chamber of Commerce to oversee the skatepark. Multiple groups have come forward over the past year interested in different projects relating to the skatepark, presenting the need for Discover Grand Forks to bring this request to Council. Council instructed staff to tailor the stewardship agreement for five years and specified that a City staff member be present on the subcommittee as an advisor.

## #3. BYLAWS



Council gave first three readings to two bylaws during their regular meeting.

1. Bylaw 2082 - Revenue Anticipation 2022 which allows the City to secure a line of credit in anticipation of 2022 tax revenues.
2. Bylaw 2065-A1 - Water Regulations Bylaw Amendment, which if approved would implement updated outdoor water regulations and restrictions for users of the City's water system
