#1. FELINE RESCUE SOCIETY

Council provided Boundary Helping Hands Feline Rescue Society another Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund (DMAF) acquired property located in Johnson Flats. This allows the City to proceed on schedule with community flood protection works in North Ruckle, as well as allows the Society to continue operations until June 30, 2022, at which point this location will also need to be cut off from utilities. Council also noted that this new property located within Johnson Flats is prone to flooding and that the society would need to be willing to accept these risks if they wished to proceed.

#2. RDKB BUILDING PERMITS



Council directed Staff to work with the RDKB in expediting the building permit process for facility upgrades at the Grand Forks Regional Landfill. This project brings a \$1.8 million dollar project to the community as well as strengthens our community diversion program keeping compost and recyclables out of landfills. Council further directed staff to review the current building bylaw.
