#1. STREET VENDORS

Council approved a few short-term strategies to regulate street vendors on public property, which would allow vendors in the short term to sell products on some City properties until a formal bylaw is created.

#2. Q1 FINANCIALS

Council received the City's first quarter financials which outline expenses and revenues from January to March. Staff noted that many projects had either not started yet or have just finished procurement, therefore the report does not show significant capital expenses yet.

During Council's special meeting on May 12, The City's independent auditor the results of the 2020 financial audit. The auditor reported that all accounting practices and findings matched Canadian standards. This report marks the end of an annual process required by the community charter.
