#1. EXTREME WEATHER SHELTER

The City received a temporary use permit application for 2320 78th Avenue; this property is zoned as CU (Community Use) and under such does not permit for a temporary shelter. BC Housing has requested a temporary use permit to allow for a temporary extreme weather shelter to be facilitated for the coming winter months. Notices to the public and surrounding property owners will be distributed on October, 21 and written public feedback will be accepted until October 30.



#2. 12 DAYS OF DEALS

Council partnered with the Downtown Business Association to help sponsor the 12 Days of Deals event put on annually by the Downtown Business community. The 12 Days of Deals is a marketing campaign that encourages consumers to shop locally over the 12 day period, strengthening local business throughout the holidays. This campaign is planned to begin Tuesday, December 1.



#3. COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Council voted not to pursue a question on the ballot regarding a year-round shelter in the City and rather resolved to review budget options to utilize a communications consultant to facilitate public discussion and engagement in 2021. This will enable the public to make an informed decision on the topic of a year-round shelter.
