

# CITY OF GRAND FORKS COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS SEPTEMBER 14, 2020

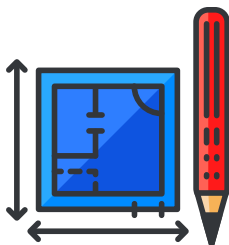

## #1. DOWNTOWN 30KM SPEED ZONE

During Councils, June 29, 2020, Regular meeting Council directed staff to collect public feedback regarding different traffic calming measures in the downtown core. After analyzing the results of the survey, Council resolved to create a 30km/h zone in the downtown core. Council also resolved that an all-way stop be introduced at the intersection of 2nd Street and 72nd Avenue. Staff will be adding these items to the workplan. Stay tuned for additional information regarding when to expect the new signage.



## #2. COMMUNITY CENTRE UPDATE

Community Futures along with Urban Arts presented plans for the Grand Forks Community Centre Project. The addition of a community centre in Grand Forks would cost approximately \$9.7 Million and would provide multiple meetings spaces, a community hall, and is proposed to host the Emergency Operations Centre when required. As a next step Council asked staff to bring back a financial report regarding the project.
