4 Easy Options:

- 1. Pre-authorized payment plan**
The City of Grand Forks offers an automatic prepayment plan for property taxes through payment on the due date or monthly pre-authorized debits from your bank account.

The benefits :
 - Spread the estimated cost over 12 monthly debits
 - Accrue interest on prepaid balancesNote: Available only for properties with no outstanding balance
- 2. Internet banking**
Set up prepayments through your financial institution
- 3. Lump sum payments**
Make a lump sum payment to your tax account anytime throughout the year at City Hall or online through your financial institution.
- 4. Interac e-Transfer®**
At your convenience send by email with payment through your financial institution.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Avoid the line. *Go Online:*

You can pay your City of Grand Forks account online or send an Interac e-Transfer® to epayments@grandforks.ca (see details inside). Just set the City of Grand Forks up as a bill and use your tax or utility account number. You control when your payments are made and how much.

In person:

from 9:00am-4:00pm Monday – Friday

Locate account number on the front of your Utility Invoice or Property Tax Notice; use this number as your account number.</p> <p>Contact your financial institution for more information.</p>	<p>Pre-Authorized Payment Plan</p> <p>The City of Grand Forks offers an automatic prepayment plan for property taxes and utility billing through monthly or due date pre-authorized withdrawals from your bank account.</p> <p>Visit City Hall and complete the form setting up pre-authorized payments and include a void cheque that has the account you would like to use.</p>	<p>Mail (Canada Post) or Courier</p> <p>Forward a cheque or postdated cheques together with the payment stub of your Property Tax Notice or Utility Invoice to the City of Grand Forks, Box 220, Grand Forks, BC V0H 1H0</p> <p>Make your cheque payable to the City of Grand Forks.</p> <p>For security reasons, do not mail cash.</p>	<p>24 Hour Drop Box</p> <p>Drop your payment in the mail slot located at the 4th Street door entrance to the City Hall office, 7217 - 4th Street, Grand Forks, BC, together with the payment stub of your Property Tax Notice or Utility Invoice.</p> <p>Make your cheque payable to the City of Grand Forks.</p> <p>For security reasons, do not pay in cash when using the mail slot.</p>	<p>In Person</p> <p>Make payment in person at City Hall 7217 4th Street Grand Forks, BC.</p> <p>Cash, debit, cheques, including postdated cheque. Note: Credit cards are not accepted.</p>
