

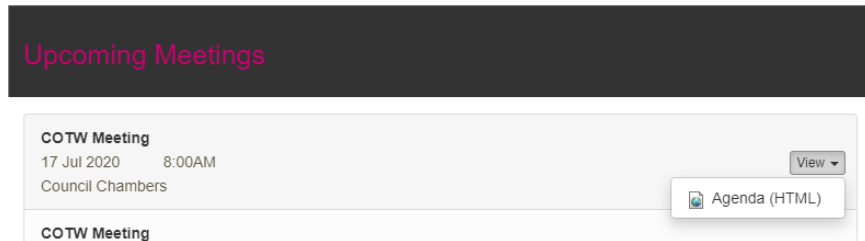


VIEWING CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS ONLINE – 2020

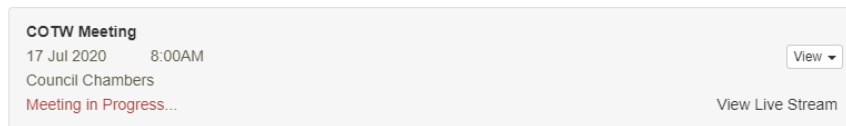
The City of Grand Forks has switched to providing Internet video streaming of meetings through the City’s own website rather than through social media platforms.

To access the video streams, start on the Council Agendas and Minutes page. A new shortcut has been created: <https://www.grandforks.ca/live>

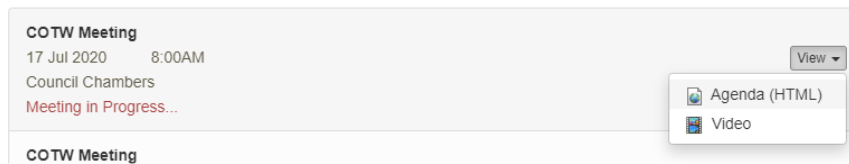
Before the meeting starts, clicking the “View” button next to the meeting will present an option to view the agenda for the upcoming meeting.



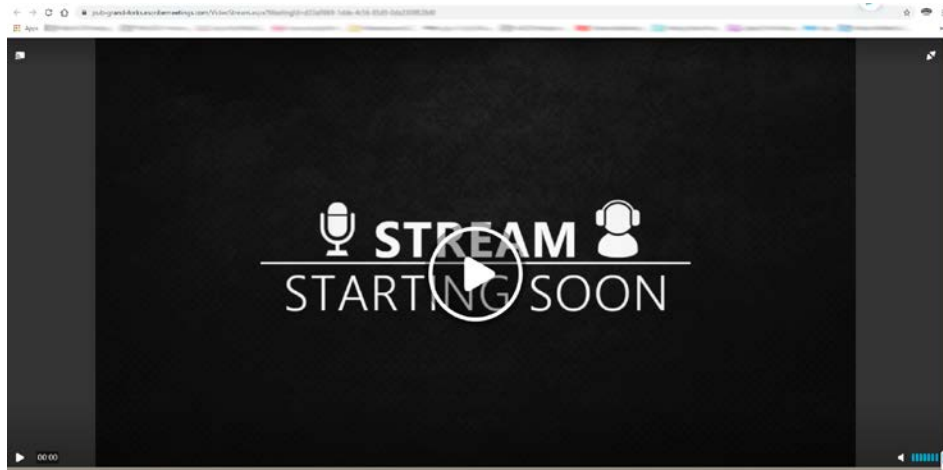
Once the video is activated for the meeting, typically a couple of minutes before the meeting starts, an option to “View Live Stream” will appear.



The “View” drop-down will also provide an option to watch video.



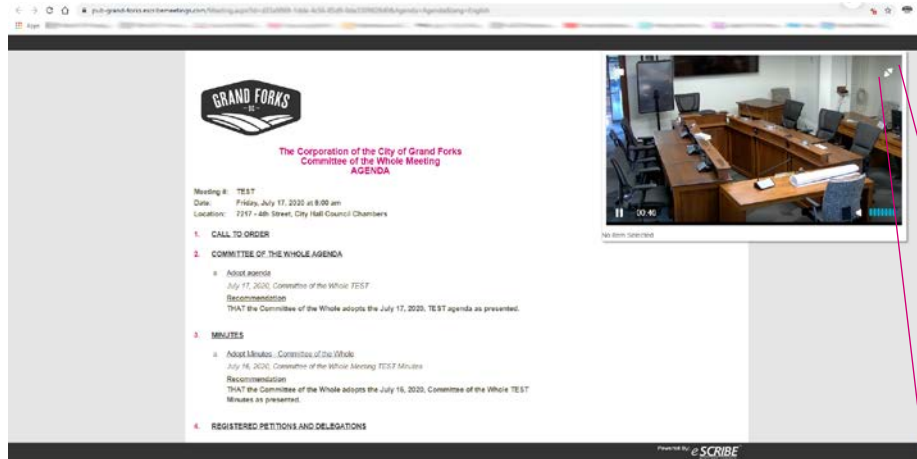
Selecting “Video” or “View Live Stream” will show the meeting full-screen in the web browser.



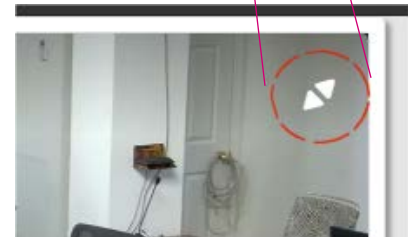


VIEWING CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS ONLINE – 2020

An alternate view is available by selecting “Agenda (HTML)” while the meeting is in progress. In this view, the agenda will show as usual, with the video appearing inset in the upper right corner of the page.



The inset video can be switched to full-screen by clicking the arrows in the upper right corner of the video.



Meeting video archives will be available from the same page when the recordings have been processed.

We are looking at other interactive options for future meetings.

The video seen on the online stream will be approximately 30 seconds later than the live meeting.
