

NOTICE TO ALL CITY OF GRAND FORKS & AREA RESIDENTS

The City of Grand Forks will be commencing paving a portion of the Trans Canada Trail (TCT) from 68th Avenue to the Nursery Trestle near Darcy Road. The City of Grand Forks has awarded the TCT paving project to Argosy Construction Group of Grand Forks, BC. Construction will be commencing Monday, September 16, 2013 and will continue thru to mid November 2013. This section of the Trans Canada Trail will be closed to all traffic during this time.

Roads in the city and surrounding area that may be affected include 68th Avenue and Darcy Road. During this time, every effort will be made to keep traffic access available whenever possible. The City of Grand Forks requests that all construction signs posted be obeyed.
