Christine Thompson representing Adhoc Committee of Boundary Museum Society:

Ms. Thompson advised Council that she and Brian Taylor are an Adhoc committee of the Boundary Museum Society who have met with Councillor Robert and Mayor Krog to discuss Museum matters. She went on to request that the Boundary Museum Society have access to the Museum building on December 27th and 28th to facilitate moving the Boundary Museum Society's office out of the "Centennial" building, advising that the artifacts will remain intact in the building. Ms Thompson advised that this access be confirmed in writing by December 19th. Councillor Robert commented that the meeting held last week was a positive meeting and complimented the Adhoc Committee. Brian Taylor commented that the meeting was positive, and stated that the new society, who will run the museum, will need the back-up of the existing museum society. Councillor Moslin inquired as to suggestions by the Adhoc Committee. Brian Taylor suggested that the Society has a job to do to allow the move and to organize in their new role of assisting, volunteer to volunteer, with the new board liaising directly with the Boundary Museum Society. Councillor Robert stated that during the regular meeting, he intends to request that Council consider adding another seat on the new Society Board of Directors, to be appointed by the Boundary Councillor Moslin inquired if this is premature, stating that consultation is Museum Society. required by the Boundary Museum Society and the Grand Forks Society for the Preservation of Arts & Culture Board of Directors.
