

- **Section** Section 4 Sectio passes. (All season radials have much less traction than winter radials.
- * There are serious consequences for not driving to the conditions. SLOW DOWN!!!
- Most accidents occur in the fall and winter (ICBC statistic).
- ** Carry safety supplies: blanket, flashlight, tools, jumper cables, etc....
- * Watch front wheel drives on ice and slush. Do not use 4 wheel drive on ice.
- * Do not pass unless safe to do so.
- * Do not pass a plow truck when placing winter abrasive/or plowing.
- **We all caution around flag persons and acci**dent scenes.
- * Commercial vehicles should carry chains and use them when chain up signs are in effect.

City of Grand Forks Snow Clearing Notice:

In an effort to keep the downtown core clear of ice and snow, the public works department requests that all residents park their vehicles in the parking lots downtown and not on the streets after a snow fall. The public works crews will be removing snow periodically throughout the winter commencing at 3:00 am. The city would greatly appreciate your cooperation with our snow clearing efforts.

Signage will be placed on the streets at least 12 hours in advance of the snow clearing operations. Any vehicles parked on the downtown streets will be towed to the parking lot south of city hall on 72nd Ave. Next to city park. If your vehicle is towed a second time, it will be towed to the towing companies yard at the owner's expense.

City staff would like to make you aware that snow piles collected from the downtown core have, in the past, included health care products, various garbage, needles and other unwanted items therefore we caution the public when allowing your children to play in the piles at our melting locations.



We ask for your cooperation with snow removal and that you keep the snow from your property on your property and not push it into the street. When plowing, the plow trucks will make two passes on each side of the street. This is to ensure that the width of the road remains as wide as possible. Also keep your vehicles on your property when possible and off city boulevards, streets, sidewalks, and cul de sacs as this can be a safety issue for snow removal crews. We ask for your patience this winter and wish you a happy holiday season.
